Code of Behaviour

Social Sport at CSU offers an inclusive, fun and respectful environment for all students both on and off campus. This Code of Behaviour applies to all participants and spectators at all times.

Behavioural Expectations:

- Playing under the influence of alcohol/drugs is not permitted. Any individuals found to be in violation of this code will be required to leave the premises immediately.
- Disruptive behaviour is not permitted, including unsportsmanlike conduct both on and off the field.
- Verbal or physical abuse of fellow team mates, opposition players or referees/officials is not permitted.
- Fighting of any nature is not permitted.

Team Captain Role:

- The team captain is responsible for all players in his/her team, as well as spectators associated with the team.
- The team captain is the only person permitted to speak to the officials during the halftime break or at the end of the game.
- Should a team wish to make a formal complaint, their team captain should do so in writing to CSU Sport Management via emailing sport@csu.edu.au

Officials will report participants who they believe to be in breach of this Code of Behaviour to CSU Sport Management. Further action, including suspension of the player or team, may be taken if required, based on the following table:

Unsportsmanlike behaviour	Player receives warning	Player is suspended for 1 week	Player ejected from competition

In the event that a warning is received, or a suspension or ejection occurs, the following parties will be notified: Player involved in the incident, Team Captain of player involved in the incident, Social Sport Coordinator and CSU Sport Management.

CSU Sport Management reserves the right to enforce further penalties to those outlined above at their discretion.
